Reporting to the Community Outreach Manager, the Seniors' Outreach Worker provides outreach services to older adults living in the Calgary community. As a member of the North East Outreach Team, you will work with people in the North East and selected South East communities providing assessment, planning and implementation of interventions, making referrals and evaluating outcomes.

- Complete needs assessment
- Create and implement intervention with assistance of client
- Provide referrals to other community resources
- Evaluation of client outcomes
- Consult with and provide consultation to professionals in the community
- Establish and maintain working relationships with community agencies
- Work collaboratively with FCSS Network Outreach Workers
- Contribute and participate in community development activities
- Act as a public representative on behalf of CSRS when required
