


Message from the President

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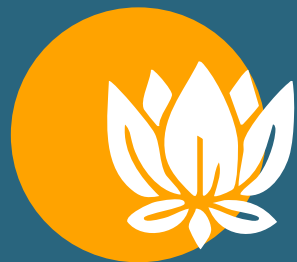

In 2024, our social work department made tremendous strides in supporting our community through the SeniorConnect, Outreach, and In Place programs. We welcomed a total of 1,625 new clients, addressing critical issues such as housing, financial support, and transportation. Together, these programs provided 130 food hampers—the highest number ever—along with pet hampers, gift cards, and emergency funding to prevent evictions and utility disconnections.

Overall, our social work department's dedication to improving lives and fostering a supportive community is evident in the data and outcomes from 2024. With a cheerful and hopeful spirit, we are excited to continue our mission of spreading positivity and making a difference.

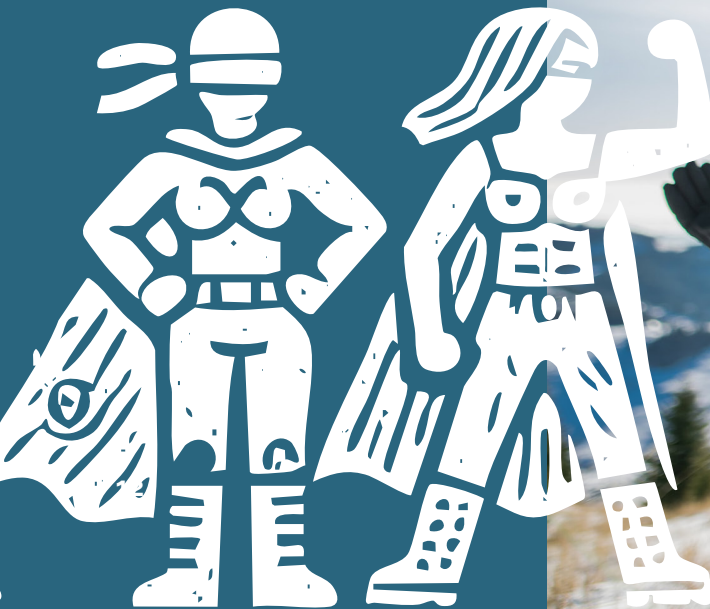

Timeless Kindness, Meaningful Impact

An Outreach Worker was assisting a 98-year-old mother and her 72-year-old daughter, who struggled with mobility in their inaccessible apartment. The mother’s isolation impacted her health, while the daughter felt overwhelmed as a caregiver. The worker helped them apply for affordable senior housing, secure funding for medical supplies, and access volunteer support services through the

S3 programs. Within a few months, the mother and daughter transitioned to an accessible home, transforming their daily lives. They now experience greater independence, reduced stress, and a renewed sense of dignity and connection.

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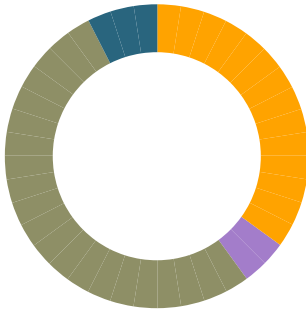

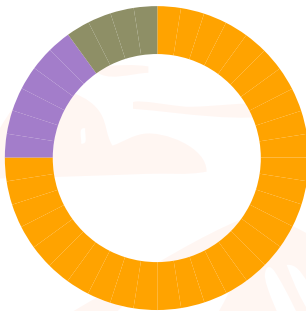
