Timeless Kindness, Meaningful Impact

An Outreach Worker was assisting a 98-year-old mother and her 72-year-old daughter, who struggled with mobility in their inaccessible apartment. The mother's isolation impacted her health, while the daughter felt overwhelmed as a caregiver. The worker helped them apply for affordable senior housing, secure funding for medical supplies, and access volunteer support services through the

S3 programs. Within a few months, the mother and daughter transitioned to an accessible home, transforming their daily lives. They now experience greater independence, reduced stress, and a renewed sense of dignity and connection.


